

## SAFETY FIRST!

- Blind Cords and Chains can pose a risk for young children and vulnerable people who could injure or even strangle themselves by insecure hanging or looped cords.
- Health & Safety issues are becoming increasingly important and those responsible for public welfare in an area should consider minimising any risks however small.
- There are many ways to reduce the risks without replacing the window blind. Use of additional safety devices may reduce the risk of strangulation (but cannot be considered foolproof).
- Alternative anti-ligature systems are available including wand operation and unique magnetic systems.
